## OUR MISSION

Up for Growth Action® is a 501(c)(4) federal legislative advocacy campaign focused on advancing policies that achieve housing equity, eliminate systemic barriers, and create more homes. Up for Growth Action, in concert with Up for Growth®, an affiliated 501(c)(3) member-network driven research and policy organization, builds and engages with a diverse network of members and stakeholders to shape pro-housing policies, develop evidence-based housing policy research and analysis, and directly advocate for federal policy.

## OUR LEGISLATIVE FOCUS

Up for Growth Action is focused on advocating for federal legislation that eliminates systemic barriers and creates more homes. We develop and lead the advocacy efforts for legislation that works to eliminate exclusionary zoning, discriminatory land use policies, and artificial barriers to housing. We partner to advance legislation that boosts resources to produce more affordable housing. We also actively support federal legislation that boosts housing assistance, prevents displacement, and ensures housing stability.

## OUR TRACK RECORD

In just two years, Up for Growth Action has established itself as the leading advocate for federal legislation that seek to eliminate systemic barriers and create more homes. Up for Growth Action led the introduction and House passage of two signature bills in the 116th Congress: H.R. 4351, the *Yes in My Backyard (YIMBY) Act*, and H.R. 4307, the *Build More Housing Near Transit Act* (language included in H.R. 2, the *Moving Forward Act*, Subtitle G-Transit-Supportive Communities, Sec. 2703).
